





Top 5 for re-export commodities:



1. Grain and grain products
2. Seed potatoes
3. Nuts
4. Cotton
5. Tobacco

Purpose of PC_{re-ex}



1. To avoid administrative burden
2. To meet consumer demand for different range of products from different countries of origin, because it is possible to split up and combine one consignment with another consignment

When you need a certificate PC_{re-ex} ?



Its not obligatory issue PC_{re-ex}

On request from exporters

What is a consignment for re-export?




- when a consignment is imported into a country (Latvia) and then exported to another third country
- commodity in this consignment is not grown or processed with the aim to change its nature in country of re-export
- the consignment can be stored, split up, combined with other consignments, repackaged

When may issue PC_{re-ex}?




1. Only where is available original PC of country of export or its certified copy
2. If the SPPS of Latvia is confident that the destination country's regulations are met

Process of PC issuance for Re-Export



PC_{re-ex} are issued based on:



* PC issued by European Union MS, which is addressed to country of destination

Certified copy of PC



A certified copy is a copy of the original PC that is validated:

- stamped,
- dated,
- and countersigned by the NPPO indicating, that it is a true representative copy of the original PC.

Certified copy of PC



It does not replace the original

Such copies are used primarily for re-export purposes

- different information covering the certifying statement
- different colour for PC (determined in Plant Quarantine Regulation of Latvia)
- information should not be transferred from original PC or certified copies

1. PC_{re-ex}
2. Original PC or its certified copy

Documents should be attached to each consignment!

What is a consignment?



Railway:

1 wagon = 1 consignment

PC_{re-ex} and certified copy of original PC should be attached for each wagon.

See:

1 vessel = 1 consignment, if there is one consignee

Road:

1 truck = 1 consignment











Cases, when PC_{re-ex} should not be issued, but should issued PC_{ex}



- If consignment is infested or contaminated with pests and inspector can apply alternative phytosanitary measures (e.g. treatment),
- If consignment is subjected to processing by changing its phytosanitary status,
- if consignment is stored for too long time.

Specific situations



1. Country of destination have special requirements - Information of compliance has not been declared on the PC
2. PC_{ex} itself is not required by Latvia, but it is required to country of destination

Country of destination have special requirements - Information of compliance has not been declared on the PC



What inspector has to do?



=> 3 Possibilities:

Possibility 1:

- applies alternative phytosanitary measures (according to phytosanitary requirements of country of destination) such as:
 - laboratory tests of samples
 - or treatment
- issues PC_{re-ex} or PC_{ex}

Possibility 2:



- On the request of exporter NPPO of Latvia requires additional phytosanitary information from the NPPO of the country of origin,
- additional phytosanitary information has been received,
- In Box 11 of PC_{re-ex}, inspector indicates received information under subheading “Additional official phytosanitary information”,
- issues PC_{re-ex} or PC_{ex}

Possibility 3:



- On the request of exporter, has been received new replaced PC with missing information from the NPPO of the country of origin
- issues PC_{re-ex} or PC_{ex}

Situation 2

PC for export itself is not required by Latvia, but it is required to country of destination

What inspector has to do?



Possibility 1:

- On the request of exporter, PCex has been issued by NPPO of the country of origin
- issues PCre-ex



Possibility 2:

If SPPS can fulfil Phytosanitary requirements of country of destination, then inspector:

- carries out visual inspection and/or sample testing
- issues PC_{ex}

Problems in Latvia by issuing PC_{re-ex}



1. Exporter does not submit original PC or certified copy to the inspector
2. Re-export consignment loses their credibility, if consignment is stored for too long time
3. Phytosanitary requirements of country of destination is different or more stringent than in Latvia and it is not possible to fulfil them.
